



- 1: Carefully cut out the black wing cross sections in part 5 marked 'X'
- 2: Cut out and roll up the body tube sections 1-8. assemble them starting with the center section 5,4,3,2,1 go on the front- 6,7,8 go on the rear; In those orders, working from part 5 outward. Roll up and glue cones 'F', and 'B' with the black side facing inward. Glue cone 'F' 2mm's inside the front, with the red flaps from the body to the OUTSIDE. Glue cone 'R' inside, and flush with the rear of the body.
- 3: Cut out the PORT(left side) and starboard (right side) wings. and glue them as follows- The flaps are at the rear and bottom, and the STAR of the PORT wing is topside. The STAR of the bottom wing is bottomsides. Set the proper wing tip pieces in to the ends with the 'T's' facing top, and the slit down; fat point toward the fold, and the thinner part toward the rear-with the glue flaps
- 4: cut and glue the center wing section, with the glue flap at the BOTTOM, and the 'P' and 'S' on top 'P' is for PORT, and 'S' is for STARBOARD. Slide the center section through the cutouts in in body part 5, so the Port and Starboard flaps protrude evenly through the corresponding sides.
- 5: Slide and glue each wing onto the corresponding 'P' and 'S' halves of the wing center section.
- 6: Carefully cut out, fold (DO NOT CREASE), the top fin. The glue flap is the rear. Fold over and Push the small flaps at the fin tip, inside while folding over and shaping the tip into a slightly rounded hump. Glue the fin halves together. Glue the top fin to the upper rear body over the outline of the shadow. Carefully match the contours and glue the fin so the shadow is completely covered.
- 7: Parts 'V' ** There is no score line seen, as this part is black, so note the shape in the 3D illustration. Score, cut and fold 'V' to match the corresponding black shadows on each lower rear side of the body.
- *** Alternate step 8: Although seldom seen, the early Regulus's had a lower fin identical to the top fin. to install, assemble the 2nd matching lower fin piece, the same as the first, and glue it on the bottom of the body directly opposite and invertedly matching the top fin
